❖ FIRST READING *Isaiah 40. 12-17, 27-end,*

Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand and marked off the heavens with a span, enclosed the dust of the earth in a measure, and weighed the mountains in scales and the hills in a balance?¹³ Who has directed the spirit of the Lord, or as his counsellor has instructed him? ¹⁴ Whom did he consult for his enlightenment, and who taught him the path of justice? Who taught him knowledge, and showed him the way of understanding?¹⁵ Even the nations are like a drop from a bucket, and are accounted as dust on the scales; see, he takes up the isles like fine dust.¹⁶ Lebanon would not provide fuel enough, nor are its animals enough for a burnt offering.¹⁷ All the nations are as nothing before him; they are accounted by him as less than nothing and emptiness.²⁷ Why do you say, O Jacob, and speak, O Israel, 'My way is hidden from the Lord, and my right is disregarded by my
