Isaiah 60 1-3, 17 – 20

Arise, shine; for your light
has come, and the glory of
the Lord has risen upon you.

²For darkness shall cover
the earth, and thick darkness
the peoples; but the Lord will
arise upon you, and his glory
will appear over you.

³Nations shall come to your
light, and kings to the
brightness of your dawn.

¹⁷ Instead of bronze I will
bring gold, instead of iron I
will bring silver; instead of
wood, bronze, instead of
stones, iron. I will appoint
Peace as your overseer and
Righteousness as your
taskmaster.

¹⁸ Violence shall no more be
heard in your
land, devastation or
destruction within your
borders; you shall call your
walls Salvation, and your
gates Praise.

¹⁹ The sun shall no longer
be your light by day, nor for
brightness shall the moon
give light to you by night;^[b]
but the Lord will be your
everlasting light, and your
God will be your glory.

²⁰ Your sun shall no more go
down, or your moon
withdraw itself; for
the Lord will be your
everlasting light, and your
days of mourning shall be
ended.
